- Recognize individuals who serve as examples to the college's learners.

Recipients are conferred at college's annual convocation ceremony and must be present at convocation. Recipients may use the following phrase in their credentials: "Awarded Honorary Diploma, NorQuest College."

Note: Please <u>do not</u> inform the individual you are nominating. All nominations will be kept confidential until the recipient is announced by the college.

Honorary diplomas are generally not awarded posthumously or in absentia, or to current faculty or staff members, current members of the Board of Governors, or to current holders of political office in Canada.
